

Co-Director Corner (goodbye and thoughts about my time with the NMC by Cayla)

I joined the NMC right when I arrived in Novato 2.5 years ago. I was expecting maybe some moms' night out events or park play dates but wasn't too hopeful of finding my "tribe." I'd been a member of some informal groups back in Colorado and attended some of their events but never really connected with any of the moms there. Events were few and far between or targeted only to stay-at-home moms. As a working mom with a kid in full-time daycare/preschool, mom friends were tough to come by.

After my move to Novato, I connected immediately with the two NMC members I met at my very first welcome event. Our kids are within a year apart and now, even at 5/6, I know they (and their moms) will be friends forever. These are my people and the main reason I am so sad to move out of Novato.

Soon after that initial event, I was peer pressured into joining the NMC Board of volunteers and it was, hands down, the best thing anyone has ever pressured me into doing. My tribe grew from three moms to nearly 30. These moms have helped me in so many ways that are completely separate from the NMC, from providing mom-perspective, picking my kid up from school when I can't, making me feel like part of a real community for the first time since moving out of my college town, and providing me with a much-needed social outlet. Now that I'm more and more involved with the NMC board, I have met and become familiar with many of our other 150ish members. I often see them forming friendships similar to those I have with my OG NMC friends and I love to see that. Mom friends are so important to maintaining that sense of self that tends to blur into the background after kids.

I am introverted by nature, and the NMC and its online networking has made it so much easier for me to comfortably approach and talk to people I've never met at NMC events. I have improved my public speaking and interpersonal skills over these 2.5 years leaps and bounds over what I've been able to do in the last 17 years of office jobs.

Now that my son is school-age, I have finally been able to connect to other parents outside of the club and that makes it a little less scary to move back to a place that does not have anything similar to the Novato Mothers Club. In those preschool years, when parents were too busy at pickup and the kids were too little to reliably be able to relate their friends' names, the NMC was invaluable to me.

I love Novato, I love how small it is while still providing everything we need, I love randomly running into 5-10 friends every time I go to the farmers' market, and I really love the NMC. I will miss it all dearly when we move. While I'm sad that my time here was so brief, I am so glad I

was able to experience Novato and everything it has to offer. The NMC is truly one-of-a-kind.
